

COBHAM RFC 15-A-SIDE VETERANS RUGBY TOURNAMENT

The tournament will be played generally in accordance with the Laws of the Game of Rugby Football as framed by the International Rugby Board and adopted by the Rugby Football Union, with the following amendments

- (1) The format of the Tournament is in the first instance a single league competition with the top 2 in the league competing with each other for the Cobham 15-a-side Veterans Cup. The losing finalist will receive a runners-up trophy.
- (2) The tournament is intended to be between teams of Veterans; ie. predominantly consisting of players over the age of 35. Whilst there will be no strict regulation of this age limitation, teams are expected to adhere to the spirit of Veterans rugby in the composition of their teams.
- (3) A side will consist of 15 players, selected from a team squad not exceeding 22 players, who will be identified to the organisers before the commencement of each match. A team squad may be changed between games. In the event of a side being unable to field a full team through injury or non availability for any reason additional players may be drafted in or borrowed subject to the agreement and approval of the tournament organising committee.
- (4) The duration of all games shall be of 12 minutes each way, with a three minute interval at half time.
- (5) Rolling substitutes are allowed at any time during the match, from within the team of 22 players, subject to the mandatory compliance with the Laws of the game that "a minimum of five players from each side shall be required to form a scrummage".
- (6) Sides should consist of 15 players in accordance with the Laws of the Game of Rugby Football.
- (7) The league will be operated under a points system. 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a loss. League positions will be determined by the points won. Then by points difference.
- (8) In the event of scores being tied at the end of a game during the knockout rounds, a further period not exceeding 5 minutes of extra time will be played; with the side in possession of the ball at the end of normal time receiving the re-start. The side scoring first will be declared the winner and the game will end. If at the end of extra time the score remains equal, then the result will be determined by a "penalty shoot-out". Each side will nominate 5 different players to take a drop goal from in front of the posts. The side in possession of the ball at the end of extra time will take the first drop kick at goal. Kicks will alternate until each side has taken all five kicks. If after 5 kicks the scores are still tied, the shoot out will continue on a "sudden death" basis, until each player from both squads has had an attempt at goal. If the result is still equal then the game will be decided by the toss of a coin.
- (9) Any players sent by the referee to the sin-bin can return to the field of play after a period of 4 minutes. Any player sent off by the referee will take no further part in the tournament.
- (10) Any disputes or disagreements not covered by the above shall be referred to the tournament organising committee, whose decision shall be final.
